Summary

Phase I of a three phase project, 116th Street is now a major east-west corridor through the Town of Fishers and Hamilton County connecting Sand Creek Bridge to Hoosier Road. The project involved construction of four lanes of concrete pavement with a grass median and left turn lanes. This project included a multi-use asphalt path, decorative lighting and signalization.
