**Project Summary:**

The rapidly growing Town of Fishers, Indiana, has an equally growing need for recreational and organized sports facilities and parks. Phase 1 of the original 29-acre Billericay Park had seven baseball diamonds to serve the needs of the local youth baseball league. Butler, Fairman and Seufert, Inc., in association with Anorlas Enterprises and K. R. Montgomery and Associates, provided the civil engineering design for this project, including layout, grading and drainage, storm water systems and detention, sanitary sewer, utility coordination, roadway design and construction cost estimating. Services also included coordination for the design of the concessions/restroom building, and coordination with the designers and owners of the adjacent high school campus that was under design at the time (and with whom several utilities and facilities are shared). Phase 2 added 8 acres to the park site, and includes development of an eighth ball diamond, a multi-purpose

community building, splash pad, playgrounds, and additional parking. The team of BFS, Anorlas Enterprises, and Perkins VonDeylen & Associates is providing design, with construction anticipated in 2006.
