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Summary:

Project consisted of reconstruction of Brady Lane and a portion of Concord Road. Brady Lane was widened from two lanes with parking to four lanes plus left turn lanes at major intersections. Work included two traffic signals, a railroad crossing, two bridges over the Elliott Ditch, curb and gutter, a storm sewer system, sidewalks and stamped concrete crosswalks. Also included were the Ross Road forcemain, the Elliott interceptor sanitary sewer, and watermains.
