Design Features

- 1.25 miles of paved path
- Parking lot
- Two large shelters with tables
- Enclosure of ditch
- Creation of a wetland/ detention basin
- Access to adjacent neighborhoods, school system, athletic facilities and Park's nature preserve.

Located in West Lafayette, Indiana, park renovation and 1.25 miles of multi-use trail. As part of the Northwest Greenway Trail, the paved paths along Kalberer Road and throughout the Park provide vital connections between the adjacent neighborhoods, the Park, and the West Lafayette Trail System.
