

DEKALB COUNTY AIRPORT TERMINAL AND MAINTENANCE FACILITY



Project: Terminal and aircraft maintenance facility.

Construction Cost: \$2,000,000

Funding: Local Funds

Summary: The terminal building (122 feet by 42 feet) is a two story building sized to accommodate the anticipated growth of the FBO and needed administrative services for at least the next decade. Most of the terminal has already been leased to the FBO. Space on the second floor is reserved for a potential restaurant. The maintenance facility (114 feet by 180 feet) was designed to house at least the Gulfstream IV. The rolling horizontal door has a clear opening of 100 feet in width and 25 feet in height. It is designed with a curtain wall at the opposite end from the bay door to allow for additional expansion. The building was constructed at a separation from the runway and at an elevation that the structure would not interfere with any future ILS on Runway 9-27.
