

FRANKFORT MUNICIPAL AIRPORT TERMINAL



Project: Terminal

Construction Cost: \$570,000.00

Funding: Local and AIP Funds

Summary: Replaces an existing cinder block building. The old building was demolished. The new building was constructed at a new site because the existing site impacted the transitional airspace of runway 4-22. The new site was required to be located in proximity of the main highway to the north of the airport for functional visibility from the highway as well as access to the airside. The 2,400 square foot, one story terminal is sized to accommodate FBO services and the airport management. The project included extension of the city water and sanitary sewer service funded locally and a 1600 square yard apron constructed with AIP funds.
