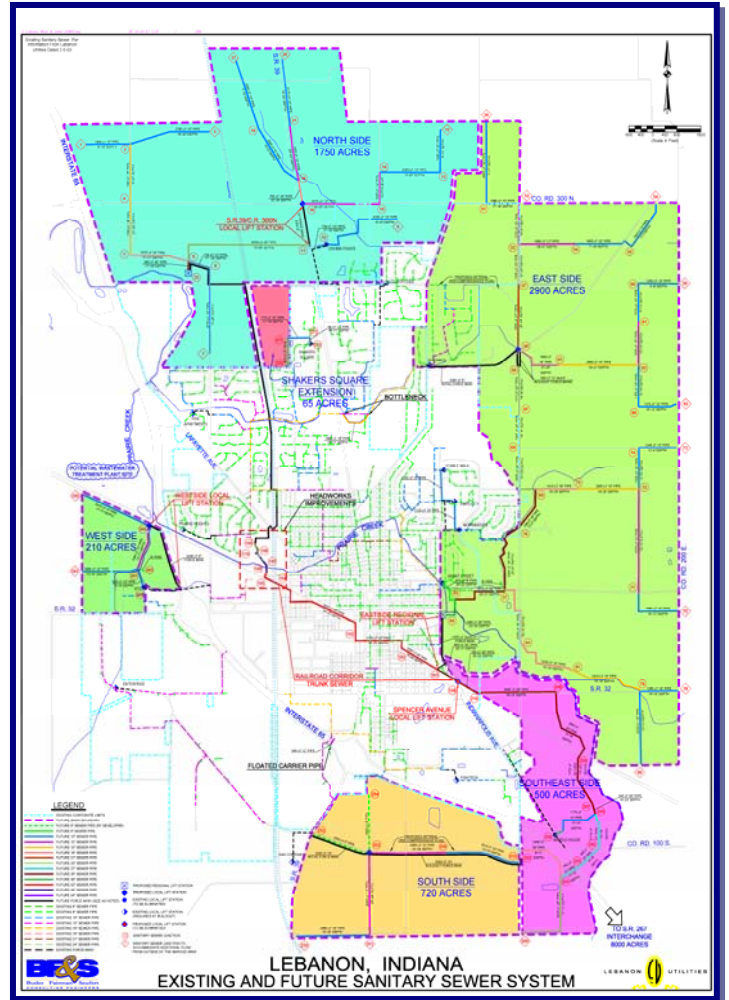

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Summary: Northside Sanitary Sewer Master Plan completed a detailed planning document for 1,750 acres on the north side of Lebanon. A regional lift station, interceptor sewer, and dual 12-inch force mains were constructed to accommodate development. Approximately 5,600 feet of 30-inch and 24-inch interceptor sewer, 11,300 feet of dual 12-inch force main and a variable speed pumping system were installed.
