

Southwest Water Treatment Plant, Plainfield, Indiana



Project: New 2 MGD Water Treatment Plant & Ground Storage Tank.

Contract Entity: Town of Plainfield

Construction Cost: \$4,500,000

Funding: Bonds

Summary: In accordance with the Master Plan update of 1993, investigation of additional sources of supply southwest of the Town resulted in the locating of a well field that is suitable for at least 4 MGD production capacity. Initial engineering and site investigation suggested that nearby higher ground would be much more suitable for the water treatment plant itself. The initial 2 MGD Water Treatment Plant project includes a 750,000 Gallon Ground Storage Tank and backwash water disposal, as well as approximately five miles of distribution main. Like the Anderson Water Treatment Plant within the Town of Plainfield, the Southwest Water Treatment Plant can easily be expanded to double its capacity.
